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



If 50% or more submit letters of protest, the expansion will be terminated. In addition, there will be a public hearing on this matter before the Board of Supervisors on October 16, 2018. The public will have the opportunity to be heard, and if they wish the ability to terminate the expansion through the protest process.







# Parceling out the economics of the San Bernardino County Fire District expansion Jay Prag, Press Enterprise

Every once in a while, a news story appears that highlights a truly classic issue in economics. The Aug. 29 story in the San Bernardino Sun about the expansion of the fire protection district is one of those stories. The gist: the San Bernardino County Board of Supervisors voted to replace the existing patchwork of service zones throughout the **San Bernardino County Fire** Protection District, which do not cover the entire county, with a single, unified service zone (FP-5) that does. This sounds innocuous — even efficient — and, yet, there is controversy about that change and the process that led to it.

Over the years, the individual service zones of the San Bernardino County Fire Protection District have been funded by relatively small parcel taxes (about \$150 per year) levied on landowners within each service zone.

The problem is: the first responders who work for the Fire Protection District must respond to fire and medical emergencies in any part of San Bernardino County (except in areas covered by a city fire department or a local fire protection district, or areas covered under a contract with Cal Fire). Since most of the county's land is not in one of the Fire Protection District service zones, that means a huge swath of the county is being served without paying the parcel tax. In economics we call this free riding.

Most goods and services that exist in the economy are produced and distributed effectively by a free market. Producers create a product as efficiently as possible and sell it to consumers. The price that consumers pay must cover the cost of production, or the business, in reality, cannot survive. But some services are impossible to produce that way. So-called "public goods" are things that are provided, but they can be used without paying at the time of use. For example, we can't charge homeowners to put out a fire when we put it out. We need our emergency services ready and able to respond before they are needed. Like all other public goods, fire services are paid for by taxes.

But the cost of public goods only covers production if the cost is shared among all users. In San Bernardino County, people can opt out of paying for the service by moving out of a Fire Protection District service zone, and they still get the service. As a result, this public good — emergency services — cannot be adequately funded. Every year, the Fire Protection District goes, hat in hand, to the county government to get extra funding to pay for those residents who are free riding. This system is simply not sustainable. As it stands, the majority of the residents of the county are subsidizing the minority — those who pay no parcel tax. Therefore, the single Fire Protection District service zone (FP-5) with one parcel tax for all of San Bernardino County is a fair decision, as it will keep emergency services adequately funded and available to everyone who lives there.

Also, the parcel tax should be paid by everyone who gets the service, so the controversy over the supervisors' vote is also a bit silly (or a misunderstanding of how representative governments work). The supervisors voted 3-2 in favor of the single service zone, and this is precisely what their constituents would have wanted. The representatives of those who aren't currently paying voted no; the representatives of the majority who are paying voted yes.

The notion that this change should be done by popular vote violates a basic premise of representative government. If asked, every individual would say they wanted their taxes to be low or zero. The individual would always rather the "other guy" pay all the taxes. Elected representatives exist to allocate taxes more uniformly, more fairly, and in a way that allows us to sustain vital services. The San Bernardino County supervisors were prudent and sensible in voting for this change and everyone in the county should be comforted knowing emergency services are fairly and adequately funded.







The land area of just Bloomington and Muscoy comprise 5854 acres. It is improbable that the whole remaining unincorporated areas of the County can be included into the remaining 5361 acres, which is smaller than the combination of Bloomington and Muscoy.

The official size of the County is 20105 square miles. The web page <a href="https://sbcfire.org/ServiceZoneFP-5.aspx">https://sbcfire.org/ServiceZoneFP-5.aspx</a>, says that the Fire Protection District provides fire and emergency medical services (EMS) to residents throughout the entire County, covering 19,278 square miles. It seems that the District does not cover the difference, or 827 square miles, likely the total of the excepted portion of lands described in Attachment A, where service is provided by other fire agencies

The 827 square mile area is equivalent to 529,280 acres, which is only 4% of the 12,867,200 total acreage of the County. The 19,278 square mile figure is equivalent to 12,337,920 acres.

# Lower the bar to challenge fee hikes

There is a process that property owners can use to challenge fire district annexations such as the one which would expand Fire Protection District 5 across the county and lead to higher annual fire protection assessments for some, most notably in Wonder Valley.

The trouble is the bars are set so high that it is nearly impossible for a genuinely grassroots effort to succeed. A quarter of property owners who own at least a quarter of the assessed value of the affected land must protest to force a public vote; 50 percent of property owners who own at least half of the assessed value of the land must protest to shut the proposal down.

This is the same protest process used when Twentynine Palms was annexed into the San Bernardino County fire department a couple of years ago.

We would like to see the county lower the bar and make it easier for property owners to challenge proposals that increase what may be called fees or assessments but look and feel and act an awful lot like taxes. Of course, the corollary is that if protests are easier to make and property owners are able to defeat measures like the zone expansion, they may be looking at a cut in their fire services. But that would be their choice to make.

County officials have often said they want residents to be more engaged in their own governance. This is why residents can go to the government center in Joshua Tree to address board of supervisors meetings through a computer link.

It is, however, not enough to be able to speak to power. We need to know that those voices are actually being heard.
