In addition, they have added an "Impacted by RDA" column. Due to our timeline, they did not have time to calculate it, but they make note of any community that could be impacted by RDA so you can assume the Estimated Revenue would be less in these notated communities. Just like before, I have added columns for the possible FP5 revenue based on number of parcels in the community and if there is a current special tax that might be an additional talking point.
